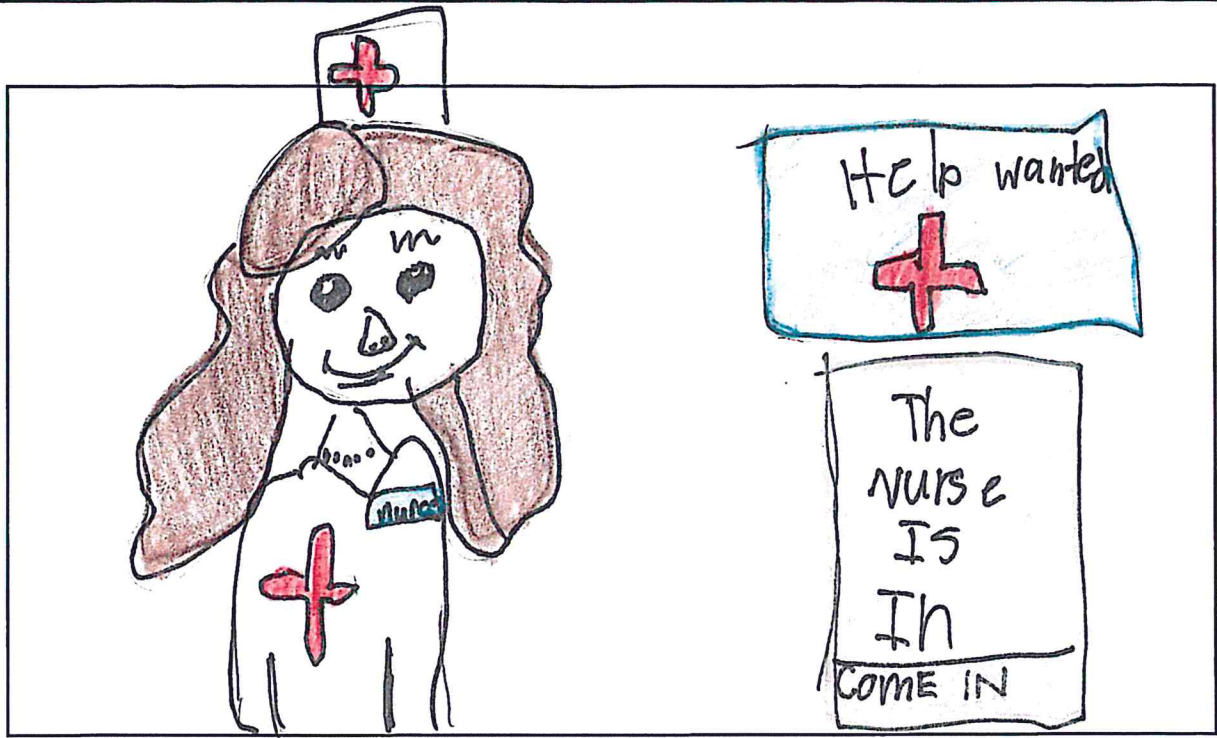
I headed to the nurse's office

too.



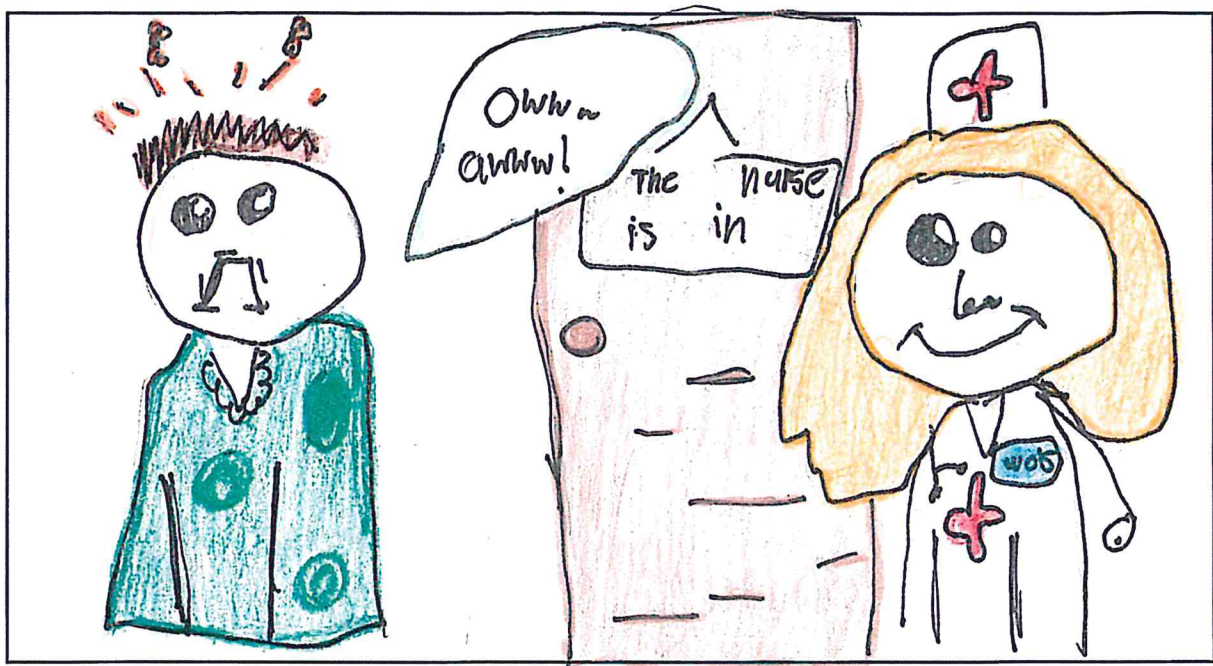
Dirty Daniel asked me, "Where are you going?"

and kept on walking.



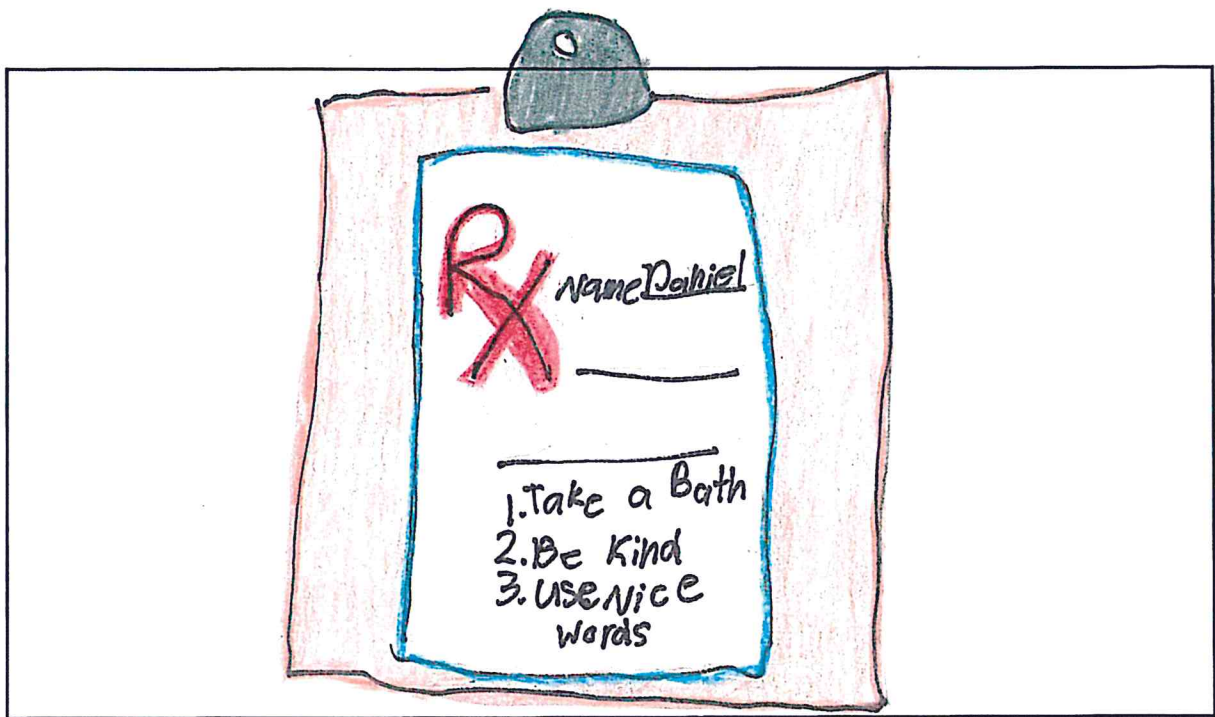
The nurse was nowhere to be found
